## **BOB** What is it and Why do you need one?

BUG OUT BAG- the term bugging out refers to the decision to leave your home due to an emergency situation. This can be man made or a natural disaster but comes when you decide you would have a better chance at keeping your family safe if you left your home

a Bug Out Bag is a self contained kit that can be carried and designed to get you through at least 72 hours independently

Also referred to as a 72 hour bag or get Out of Dodge Bag or an EVAC bag

whatever its called its main purpose is to meet the needs of you and your family for at least 72 hours and should be stored ready to grab and go either near your door or in your vehicle ( ideally you would have a separate bag in case you are on the go)
